What is Cellar Trading? Are you new?

Cellar Trading has been around for over a decade! We are your best source for well-priced, pristinely stored collectible wine. If you are looking to grow your collection, we are the most convenient way to buy the wines you want, especially if you are already a UOVO storage client.

Where does the wine that you sell come from?

We sell wine on behalf of storage clients as well as sourcing wines from our valued European and US suppliers. Most of our wines come from private collections in our storage, already here in the US.

Are the wines in good condition?

Yes. Provenance is our highest priority. With our vast network of storage clients, we can trace when the client acquired the wine. Since we have been storing wine for 20 years, we have immense data and confidence in our storage network. We also have close relationships with non-storage clients thanks to our decades of relationships that we have built with reliable collectors. We proudly will send photos of any bottles we have for sale.

Why are your wines so well-priced?

We are almost always the lowest price on Wine Searcher,

and in many cases, by quite a bit under the next price. If we are selling on behalf of a storage client, we understand that our mutual goal is to sell at a fair price where the buyers are happy with the price, and the sellers are happy with the net. We look at several market data points, particularly *Wine Market Journal*, as well as sales velocity, to determine our prices and always use auction results as the standard.

Do you send email offers?

We do! Look for our offers Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday at 11 AM Eastern time.

If I am a UOVO storage client, do I need a new login for Cellar Trading?

Yes, our ecommerce platform is separate from your storage billing. We can help you get started—just [click here and register](#)! You will need to enter your payment information again as the storage payment info does not carry over to our Cellar Trading platform.

How do I pay?

We take major credit cards. You can also pay via ACH, which will give you a 1.5% discount.

How do I ship?

If you are a UOVO Wine storage client at the Premiere level, transfer to your storage is complimentary. For Standard level storage, you will be charged a cost-efficient transfer fee. We use a temperature-controlled carrier at all times to ensure safe transport of your Cellar

Trading purchases. We also use FedEx as a common carrier, and offer flat rates for ground, 2-day, and overnight shipping. We keep a close eye on changing weather conditions. If it's the least bit too warm, we won't ship, as the wine could be ruined in transit – unless it's being shipped to another UOVO location via temperature-controlled carrier.

Are there any other fees I should be aware of?

Because we hold our license in Washington DC, we charge 10.25% sales tax. If we ship to Florida or Oregon, there is no sales tax.

Why should I buy from Cellar Trading?

We have the world's best wines—all carefully sourced and vetted, at extremely competitive prices, that can be seamlessly transferred to your UOVO Wine storage at low or no cost. Our team prides itself on our attention to detail, our vast wine knowledge, and our instinct for excellent customer service.

Can I sell my wine with Cellar Trading?

Yes! You can [click here](#) for more information. We'd be happy to take a look at your holdings and give you an appraisal and proposal for sale. Once we reach an agreement with you, we arrange for pickup or transfer of the wines via temperature-controlled carrier, inspect the wine, and offer it for sale. Our commission is a sliding scale based on overall value. We pay you weekly by ACH and provide a sales report as the wines sell.
